An index to Georgia bird records in *American Birds* (Volumes 25-37, 1971-1983) and its predecessor, *Audubon Field Notes* (Volumes 1-24, 1947-1970).—Robert W. Loftin. 1984. Occasional Publ. No. 9, Georgia Ornithological Society, 28 pp., \$4.00 by mail from G. O. S., 869 Clifton Road, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia 30307.—Complete compilation of Georgia records from the Seasonal Reports, articles, and Changing Seasons. Arranged by species and categories such as "sparrows" and "blackbirds." The index includes 376 species and four hybrids. This extensive contribution is a suitable companion to Florida's Index, F.O.S.
